

Snowy River Project Update

Federation Mining is pleased to provide an update on our progress at the Snowy River Gold Mine near Reefton on the South Island in New Zealand

Diamond Drilling

During the last month we completed a record 2,894 metres of diamond drilling.

Project to date over 11,000 metres across 50 holes drilled since the program began in April.

Project Funding

Federation continues to work closely with appointed partners Jarden, on funding options for the next stage of the Snowy River Mine. This funding will include the construction of the processing plant in 2024 and ore development which begins in the new year.

Decline Development

A total of 191 metres was developed over the month bringing the total development metres for the project to 8,300 metres to date.

Environment

All environmental monitoring was completed, and results were compliant. We are working on installing an additional polishing tank for our water treatment system.

Community

We continue to support several local community groups with their work on the West Coast. Planning is underway for the Reefton A&P show which our team will be attending. More information will be shared closer to the event for anyone that wants to drop by and meet the team.

Health & Safety

There were no recordable injuries during the month. Several of our team attended a health and safety training course on the North Island during the month. NZ Mine Rescue is planning an exercise onsite and we provided an adjudicator to the recent Victorian Mine Rescue Comp in Australia.

Recruitment

Current vacancies on site include Jumbo Operators and Electricians.
